The Pastor Said:

In case you missed the truth about glorifying God: you can be a spiritual mentor. During the month of September, Rick Bailey and myself will be sharing the Good News. I'll be on vacation the first two Sunday's, visiting grandkids at the beach. Lonie needs a good break.

I wrapped up a sermon series in August on Glorifying God: it is our purpose. In my last message I shared that being a spiritual mentor is the most influential way to glorify God. The easiest way is to open your mouth and sin. The most important is to live your life in a manner worthy of Jesus' salvation.



That means when I return from vacation I'll be sharing a steady dose of spiritual mentorship. Let me quote myself. "If the easiest way to glorify God is to open your mouth, then every Christian can do that. If the most important way to glorify God is to live your life worthy of His salvation, then every Christian can do that, through the power of the Holy Spirit. If the most influential way to glorify God is to be a spiritual parent, a mentor, then every Christian can do that with the guidance and wisdom of the Holy Spirit."



You are a spiritual mentor. But, are you being intentional? Are you looking for people who need to be mentored? Are you capturing the opportunities to mentor people?

I would encourage you to find two other people and meet with them once a week. When you meet, ask the question, how can I pray for you? Each person needs to give an answer and faithfully pray that next week. That means all three people will need to be good listeners. Each person will need to offer a scripture passage. Each person will need to provide comfort. I'll be spelling out more details about being a spiritual mentor September 15, 22, 29. See you in church on Sunday.


