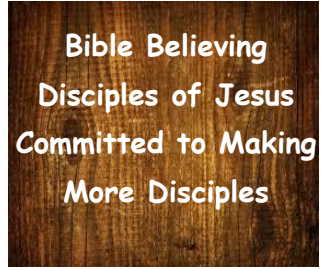


The Pastor Said:
